Job Description

The Vancouver Ultimate League is seeking several energetic and organized individuals to be responsible for delivering our youth camp programs for elementary school-aged children during the summer in Vancouver. The focus of these programs is on the spirit of the game, and having fun with a disc. With direction and support from the VUL, the instructors will administer all aspects of the program, from supervision of program participants, to lesson planning, recording and monitoring participation, and liaising with parents.

The instructors will need to commit to a minimum of 5 days per week and must be available for at least one full week that the programs will be offered. There are six separate weeks being offered for this year's summer program; therefore, interested candidates may apply to work for more than just one week of this program. - Post-secondary education, preferably with a concentration in sports and recreation, leadership, or community development.

- Experience working with school-aged children, specifically elementary school students; Interest and background in sports and recreation.
