Position Title: Juniors Club Coach

Organisation: Vancouver Ultimate League Society

Reports to: Youth Club Coordinators

Work Type: Part-time, Contract

Compensation: Stipend, contingent on completion of all required responsibilities

About the VUL: The Vancouver Ultimate League Society (VULS) is a non-profit society dedicated to organising, promoting and supporting the sport of ultimate in Vancouver. You can read more about the VUL [here](#).

Job Description: As a coach of one of four amazing youth club teams under the VUL umbrella, you will work with 1-2 other coaches this upcoming summer season. As a coach you will supervise, teach, inspire a competitive youth ultimate team during the summer season (June-August). You will be required to attend and lead two practices each week and all tournaments that your team attends.

### Duties and Responsibilities

**Note:** Some duties and responsibilities may vary slightly depending on the competitive youth program you are working with.

- Complete background checks and training required by the VUL, BCU, or Ultimate Canada, and adhere at all times to the [VULS Youth Supervisor Code of Conduct](#)
  - Training includes completing the [NCCP Competition-Introduction and Development level](#)
- Attend all team practices and tournaments as both a chaperone and coach.
- Develop and execute practice plans in partnership with the other coaches, adjusting accordingly after weekly evaluations
- Ensure that activities undertaken:
  - Fall under long term athlete development (LTAD).
  - All programs are suitable for the age, experience, ability, and fitness level of the athletes.
  - Athletes are educated about their own responsibility in contributing to a safe environment.
- Focus on developing a positive, fun, inclusive, and spirited team culture
- Provide weekly status updates to the Coordinators
- Complete end-of-year feedback survey
- Any other coaching-related duties reasonably requested by the Coordinators

### Qualifications

#### *Required*

- Strong interest in developing the game of ultimate with youth
- Strong ultimate background, including a demonstrated understand of Spirit of the Game
- Agree to a Code of Conduct and complete a criminal record check (once every five years)
- 19+ for regional teams, 21+ for touring teams

#### *Desired*

- Previous experience teaching and/or coaching youth (i.e. youth leader, instructor)
- NCCP or USAU coaching certifications
- First Aid certification
- Experience playing ultimate at the provincial or national level

### Benefits

- Training opportunities - NCCP certification, First Aid, etc
- Stipend, contingent on completion of all required responsibilities
- Opportunity to develop your leadership and ultimate skills
- Coach kit
- Expenses reimbursed for travel to tournaments.
